

Dog Procures Fire

1. tsi' ʔ khwa stqwi'lkups khwa schint.
The People had fire.
2. ku'm 'uutmish schint 'ap[ʔ] stqwi'lkups.
Only People had fire.
3. ku'm 'a hnt''lāne' lut 'ap[ʔ] stqwi'lkups.
Wolf had no fire.
4. ku'm laqhtj'wes khwi'ya twa hnq'oq'os'mj.
Wolf and Dog were friends.
5. ku'm ne' guʔ 'a hnt''lāne' che' ch 'itqwi'lkup.
The Wolves [thought], we ought to have fire.
6. hoy 'ekustm ʔe 'a hnt''lāne' ʔa hnq'oq'os'mj khuysh chituuskwint te'l schint.
Wolf told Dog, go get it from the People.
7. ku'm khwi' ʔ 'emtm ʔe 'uuts'e'l'l 'emtm.
Then here he was fed! Just as he arrived he was fed.
8. hoy hnsłpmints khwi' 'atsmi' chitkwjinus.
He forgot that he was supposed to take the fire.
9. tsi' ʔ hoy.
That's all.

Notes:

Some sounds dropped by rule (eg, [ʔ] of $\sqrt{?epʔ}$ before s- initial word) provided in square brackets; initial h's are retained, though they may not be pronounced.

Some vowels unexpectedly lowered, others not lowered where expected: Line 1 khwa unexpectedly lowered; also, word for 'dog' is given as (*twa*)*nququsmí* and *nququsmí*, both with u's (and a schwa) rather than expected lowered o's.
